

# Anglican Faithfuls donate over 2000 nets to Bwindi Campaign

In 2010, Buy-a-Net was contacted by Dr. Paul Williams, Medical Superintendent of Bwindi Community Hospital (BCH). He asked Buy-A-Net to provide bed nets and anti-malaria medicines to BCH, to tackle the single leading killer of mothers and children in the area serviced by the hospital.

Bwindi Community Hospital is a Church of Uganda (Anglican) Hospital under the Diocese of Kinkiizi. It is staffed by a team of 115 doctors, nurses, midwives, and other health workers and support staff. 70% of

our employees are from the local area, and 96% are from Uganda. The vision of BCH is to work towards “A healthy and productive community free from preventable disease and with excellent health services accessible to all.” A partnership was struck between BCH and Buy-a-Net. Since that time, Anglican Faithfuls, particularly the Anglican Church Women of Canada, have contributed over 2,000 bed nets to the Bwindi Community Hospital campaign. In April 2011, Gail Fones, Board Chair of Buy-a-Net will deliver 2,000 bed nets to the Hospital, and visit the communities and meet the mothers and children who have been protected because of the generosity of Anglican Canadians.
